The following information explains how personal data is processed by the data controller and the data processors, if any, in order for us to perform our services and fulfil our obligations towards the registered person (the data subject).

- The data controller, the municipal board (Kommunstyrelsen) of Hjo municipality (Hjo kommun), will be processing the gathered data.
- The purpose of the personal data processing is to collect correct information, in order for the right vaccine to be given to the right pupil, as well as to guarantee the identification of the registered pupil.
- The personal data processing is based upon the General Data Protection Regulation article 9 h Processing is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine, the provision of health or social care or treatment, as well as article 6 c Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject. Within the School Health Services, processing of personal data is regulated according to the Patient Data Act.
- Those who can take part of the personal data are the members of staff of the School Health Services. Since Hjo municipality (Hjo kommun) serve under the *Public Access to Information and Secrecy Act*, the municipality may give out information/documents containing personal data, unless there is reason for secrecy.
- Personal data will be saved and disposed of according to the disposal and filing guidelines of the document management plan of Hjo municipality (Hjo kommun).
- The data subject can make a request to the data controller for access to, rectification or removal of personal data or to request a limitation of the processing. The data subject can also object to the processing.
- The data subject also has the right to data portability, i.e. a right, when technically possible, to transfer personal data from one data controller to another data controller.
- The data subject has the right to make a complaint to the Swedish Data Protection Authority (Integritetsskyddsmyndigheten), which is a supervisory authority.
